Many changes to the **Comprehensive Medication Review (CMR)** service are taking effect in 2013, and OutcomesMTM™ wants to ensure you are prepared!

2013 CMR Changes

CMRs for LTC Patients

OutcomesMTM-eligible patients who reside in long-term care (LTC) facilities will be eligible to receive the CMR service in 2013. Similar to all OutcomesMTM-eligible patients, the pharmacist must provide the Standard Patient Takeaway to the CMR recipient following the completion of the CMR. As in the past, these patients remain eligible to receive the prescriber consultation service as well.

Standard Patient Takeaway

Starting in January 2013, pharmacists must provide OutcomesMTM-eligible patients with a **Standard Patient Takeaway** at the conclusion of the CMR.

Components of the Takeaway include:

- Cover letter
- Personal medication list (PML)
- Medication action plan (MAP)
